Victoria Park Race Course


Sunday, July 31 2011

This Sunday's race is a 6 hour event at **Victoria Park Racecourse**. Please take note of the following time line:

7.30am	Set up our Pit area (please come and help – there is a lot to do!)
<b>8.00am</b>	<b>All students need to be at our pits for Registration</b>
8.30am	Track Marshall briefing; for those who have completed the training
8.40am	Team photos
8.50am	Team managers' meeting
9.05am	Pedal Prix cars are called for Grid Line Up
9.45am	Grid is fully formed – grid must be clear except for riders, cars and officials
9.55am	Rolling start as per May race
10.00am	National Flag then Race starts
4.00pm	Race concludes

There are currently 182 cars registered for this event, in 4 categories. We are competing in Category 1 – Primary (3 bikes) and Category 2 – Junior Secondary (1 bike). Our pit sites for this race are 4, 5 & 6. We are in pretty much the same spot as for May. Parking at the site is limited to surrounding streets including Wakefield St and a large parking area in Victoria Park Racecourse off Fullarton Rd. **No cars are permitted to remain inside the Pedal Prix track.**
